



## **ACHIEVING THE TTNO STATUS OF “RECOGNIZED TEACHER”**

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All Recognized Practitioners are eligible to become Recognized Teachers.

If there is any question about the Student Teacher’s suitability the TTNO reserves the right to decline Recognized Teacher status

### **RELATIONSHIP TO THE THERAPEUTIC TOUCH NETWORK OF ONTARIO**

The student teacher:

1. Is a Recognized Practitioner in good standing with the TTNO
2. Has been a Recognized Practitioner for a minimum of two years prior to workshop submission.
3. Participates in Teachers Collective activities where possible.
4. Agrees to:
  - be Mentored by a TTNO Recognized Teacher
  - follow the Curriculum and Guidelines for Teaching Therapeutic Touch® and
  - submit workshop materials for each level taught following the format in the Guidelines.
  - read and sign the Statement of Ethics and Conduct for the Teaching of Therapeutic Touch.

### **CONTINUING STUDIES**

The student teacher has:

1. Repeated the submitted Level with at least 2 different teachers. This is to:
  - experience a variety of personal teaching styles and methods suited to the applicant
  - develop the required workshop materials in his/her own style
2. It is recommended that the student teacher complete the “TT Student Teacher Form for Reviewing/Auditing a Workshop” in the Guidelines at least once for each level taught and review it with her Mentor.
