



MAINTAINING THE TTNO STATUS OF “RECOGNIZED TEACHER”

YOU ARE A TTNO MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING

This means that each year you will:

1. Maintain the status of Recognized Practitioner
2. Pay your annual membership fee as a Recognized Teacher

TEACHING REQUIREMENTS

1. Annually complete the “Self-Assessment: Teaching of Therapeutic Touch®” for personal use.
2. During the past year have completed one of the following:
 - Taught at least one Therapeutic Touch workshop
 - Reviewed a workshop submission for the Teacher Liaison Committee
 - Audited a Therapeutic Touch workshop, preferably a basic level, by another Recognized Teacher and completed the audit form developed for student teachers and reviewed it with the teacher of the workshop
 - Developed an approved new Continuing Education workshop.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

1. Each year, the Recognized Teacher may choose to do ANY ONE of the following:
2. Attend a Teachers Day.
3. Serve actively on the Teacher Liaison Committee.
4. Mentor a Student Teacher.
5. Present at a Teachers Day, a TTNO-approved Event or a Session at the Annual Conference.
6. Facilitate a Professional Development Day.
7. Attend a pre-approved workshop that enhances your teaching of Therapeutic Touch.
8. Completed a second item from the Teaching Requirements list.
